

## EVANS SECURES £500K LEICESTER CONTRACT

Derbyshire based bespoke pre-cast concrete specialist, Evans Concrete, has been awarded a £500,000 contract by Bowmer & Kirkland for work on Dunelm's new HQ in Leicestershire

The multi-million pound development that was designed by Nottingham based CPMG Architects Ltd will move the homeware firm's HQ from its current location in Syston, to purpose-built premises at Leicester's Watermead Business Park.

Evans Concrete will provide the concrete cladding being used on the building. For this they will be designing, supplying and erecting over 110 concrete panels, each weighing up to 13 tonnes. The panels will be supplied in two contrasting colours, black and white. The black panels being manufactured with a special mix of black granite aggregate and the white panels being produced with Spanish dolomite aggregate.

Chris Foster, managing director of Evans Concrete commented: "It is great to be working with Bowmer & Kirkland on this project which will create superb premises for the client. The panels we will be creating a fantastic facade to Dunelm's new headquarters"

Evans will begin working on the project early 2011.

The new premises will house offices, meeting rooms, a mock shop, testing laboratory, a café, first-aid room and shower rooms as well as plant and equipment areas, a delivery area and 230 parking spaces.
